Onboarding and Pre-Season Prep:

- □ I have been onboarded to to Fenworks Platform and am set as a manager of my school page
- □ I have checked with my school's IT to ensure the Fenworks email domain is unblocked
- □ I have joined the Fenworks Discord Server and have the coach role (message an admin if you do not have this role)
 - Turn notifications to ALL MESSAGES for the "Important Announcements" channel in the Discord for all important updates and weekly announcements
- □ I have read the Season Information, General Rules, and League Structures sections for my state (linked below) and have reviewed the rules for each game I am rostering a team for
